

# Packing List

- 2 rolls of toilet paper
- 1 small plastic jar of peanut butter
- 1 small plastic jar of jelly
- 1 set of twin sheets
- bath linens and beach towel
- soap/shampoo/toiletries
- wind-up or battery alarm clock (with electricity so erratic, an electric clock will not help)
- Bible and extra Bible to give to a Jamaican friend
- Notebook/pencils
- Sunglasses/sunscreen/bandanna/cap
- Camera with plenty of batteries (or video camera)  
(Disposable cameras are great)
- Flashlight
- Ladies – bring mid-thigh shorts, no spaghetti straps (3 finger rule) and at least one skirt, capris or pants for church (see dress code for additional information).
- Men – bring one nice casual outfit for church (see dress code for additional information).
- Sandals are fine for church, but flip-flops are *not* okay for church!
- 4-6 shirts (no tank tops in community but sleeveless ok)
- 1 pair of good walking shoes
- work clothes and work socks (at least 1 pair per day)
- 3-4 casual shirts
- 9-10 pairs of underclothing
- 1 pair of pajamas
- 1 swimming suit (one-piece for women and trunks for the guys)
- 1 pair of flip-flops (for shower and lounging)
- 1-2 water bottles- you will refill these at our coolers regularly
- Bug spray
- Money for snacks and souvenirs - should be in small bills (1's, 5's, and 10's)
- 1 package of 250 paper plates to donate to the camp
- Please also bring a package of 33-gallon trash bags, paper towels or napkins to donate to the camp
- NOTE: Please do not bring hair dryers, curling irons or regular irons. Electricity is very expensive and unreliable!
- We always appreciate donations of Depends diapers (size adult s/m) for the infirmary, toys for treasure boxes used in the classrooms and sugar-free candy.

## **\*\*REMINDER\*\***

Jamaicans need clothes –bring what you think you can leave behind for someone else to wear. We challenge people to collect hand-me-downs from others or shop at a thrift shop, wear these items all week, and then leave them for Jamaicans. You can also leave towels and sheets. If you would like to donate additional household items for a thrift shop, see your leader for the list of those items to bring.
